Reading is at the heart of any successful school program. Research findings from the National Assessment of Educational Progress (Langer, et al., 1990) clearly show a relationship between required reading and higher reading performance.

To help our students improve their reading skills, all incoming students at Seton Catholic Middle School are required to read at least three books over the summer. It is suggested that students choose books written by different authors. To find a list of books at your child's reading level and of interest to him/her, he/she should go to <http://www.lexile.com/findabook/Parents.aspx> and choose a book from a list you can generate. Lexile scores can be found on the MAP test results page that was sent home and on the letter that was sent via email on June 16. Students should select books that they have not already read from 3-different categories. Please remember that not all books on this list will be appropriate for your child to read based on your family values.

For each book read, your child should answer one of the questions below. Answer a different question for each book. Each answer should be a well-developed paragraph of at least eight sentences. This will be the first graded assignment in Communication Arts. Assignments will be graded based on meeting the length requirements and fully answering the question. To receive full credit, your child must give the assignments and the parent certification form to his Communication Arts teacher at the beginning of the 2011-2012 school year.

1. Which event in the book would you change? Why?
2. Which character was your favorite? Compare this character to yourself or to one of your friends.
3. What did you learn from this book?
4. What would you say to the author of this book if you could talk to him/her?
