In order to be considered for the A honor roll, a student must have a GPA of 3.67 or higher. The GPA for the B honor roll must be between 2.67 and 3.66. A student may not be on either honor roll if he/she has any grade below a C-.

A student is considered to be on Academic Probation if he/she has one or more F's and/or 3 or more D's. A student is considered "at-risk", if he/she has 1 or 2 grades of D. Students in these two categories will work with STAR teachers, counselor and/or myself to improve these grades.
