

TCCES St Gabriel Campus Uniform Policy

2011–2012 (revised August 2011)

Grades K – 5

Shirt

Colors– Solid only – white, red, navy blue

Sleeves – Long or short sleeve only – no sleeveless

Collar – All shirts must have a turtleneck or collar – crew neck, Henley or V-neck are not acceptable.

Ribbed shirts are not acceptable. Shirts should be tucked in at all times.

Layered shirts are permitted as long as the shirts follow the above guidelines.

The St. Gabriel School logo shirts are always acceptable.

Pants

Colors – Solid only – navy blue or tan/khaki

Denim fabric is not allowed in any color.

Elastic waist pants are acceptable.

If the pants have belt loops, a belt is recommended.

Leggings/flare-bottom pants are not acceptable.

Shorts/Capris

Colors – Solid only – navy blue or tan/khaki

Shorts/Capris may be worn only in August/September and May/June

Shorts must be mid-thigh or longer in length.

Jumper/Skirt/Skorts

Jumper – The St. Gabriel plaid, solid navy blue, or tan/khaki

Skirt/Skort – The St. Gabriel plaid, navy blue or tan/khaki

Sweater/Vest

Color – **Solid** only– red, white or navy blue

Style – Crew neck, V-neck or cardigan, pull over, button up or zippered.

Fleece material and hooded sweaters are allowed.

Socks/Tights

Socks or tights must be worn to school at all times.

Preschool

Preschool students should dress in comfortable play clothing that is appropriate for their daily activities. **Socks must be worn at all times.**

****The principal reserves the right to change or make the final interpretation on all dress code questions.**

****Occasional casual dress days will be allowed at the discretion of the principal.**

****On Liturgy Days, all students MUST be dressed according to the Uniform Policy. No out of uniform passes may be used on Liturgy Days.**

****On Dress Your Best Days, students can wear uniform or Dress Your Best (no denim, no shorts/capris) students must have socks/tights on. No strapless/sleeveless clothing.**
