

DRESS CODE
St. Margaret Mary School
Students in Kindergarten through Fifth Grade
2011-2012

The purpose of the dress code is to maintain the focus of each day on educational pursuits.

Shirts

Colors White, red, or navy --- solid colors only --- no logo (except TCCES)
Sleeves Long or short sleeve --- no sleeveless
Collar Polo, Oxford, Peter Pan, or turtleneck style
NO T-shirt, crew neck, Henley, or V neck allowed
Specifics Shirts must be tucked in at all times
St. Margaret Mary Logo shirts are always acceptable

Pants

Colors Navy blue or tan/khaki --- solid colors only
Specifics Pockets on the legs are allowed
Pants may not be extremely baggy, loose or long

Shorts/Capris

Color Navy blue or tan/khaki --- solid colors only
Specifics Shorts and Capris may be worn in August/September and May/June
Dress shorts must be longer in length (mid thigh-no short shorts, no athletic shorts)

Skorts/Skirts

Color Navy blue or tan/khaki --- solid colors only
Specifics Skirts must not be too tight or too short (should come just above knee)
Skorts should look like a skirt, with attached shorts underneath

Jumper/Shirt Dress

Color Navy blue/red/ or tan/khaki --- solid colors only --- no logo
Specific Length should be the same as skirt
Shirt dress must have cap or long sleeve

Sweaters/Vests/Sweatshirts

Color Navy blue/red/white --- solid colors only --- no logo (except TCCES)
Style Pull over sweater --- crew neck or V-neck
Cardigan sweater --- button, zipper front, hooded sweater allowed
Dress shirt or blouse must be worn under sweater, vest, or sweatshirt
Only solid, non-hooded sweatshirts, plain or school sweatshirts with logo
Only Fifth graders may wear Seton sweatshirts-SOLID COLORS ONLY
All students may wear "Future Zephyr" sweatshirts

Socks/Tights

Color Navy blue/tan/khaki/red/white --- solid colors only --- no logo
Specifics Socks or tights must be worn when wearing shoes (not sandals)

Shoes

Color Dress shoes -- no bright or neon colors
Tennis shoes --- white or black --- any shoes with ties must be tied
NO BOOTS (even dress boots) --- are allowed during the school day.
Sandals may be worn in May/June and August/September.
Sandals must have a strap across the ankle and be a neutral color-- no bright or neon colors
No flip-flops of any kind
Additional pair of Tennis shoes needs to be left at school at all times for Phys. Ed. These shoes must be tie or Velcro (no slip-ons or zippers)

SHORTS ARE TO BE WORN UNDER SKIRTS/JUMPERS ON PHYS ED DAYS.

No extremes in make up, jewelry, or accessories (hair decorations, belts, etc.) are allowed. Everything must match the dress code colors.

Hair should be neatly trimmed and pulled away from face. For boys, hair should not touch collar, eyebrows, or be below ears in length.

Due to the fact that we have monkey bars, parents may want to consider having children wear shorts under skirts or jumpers.

It is the responsibility of the parents to see that children are dressed according to this dress code before leaving for school.
